#### Part III: Notes on Strategic Directions

In specific terms, the Office will in the short- to medium-term record measurable achievements in the following areas:

- Improved performance of prosecution of cases that require specialised prosecution;
- Improved cycle time within which legal advice is provided to clients;
- Provision of quality legal services and representation to O/M/As.

### Part IV: Reporting lines and requirements

- The ED will be required to submit quarterly performance progress reports to the Minister / AG;
- AG will submit Quarterly Progress reports on performance of the office for submission to, and discussion with, H.E. the President, through the Rt. Hon. Prime Minister;
- The AG undertakes to give feedback to the Minister and ED on the quarterly performance report;
- The AG further undertakes to provide leadership to ensure that annual performance report is prepared and submitted to the President a month after the end of the financial year;
- H.E. the President commits to personally preside over the performance evaluation sessions of Ministers within two (2) months after the end of the financial year.



# Part V: Duration of the Performance Agreement

This PA will run for the twelve (12) months coinciding with the financial year i.e. 1st April 2018 to the 31st March 2019.
